

**Winzer Krems Blauer Zweigelt Privat 2012**  
**Total Wine Price: \$17.99**

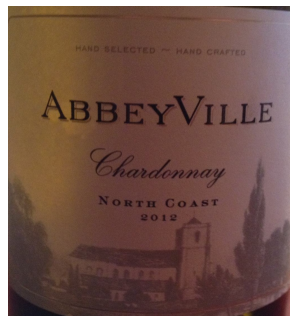
**Grape:** Blauer Zweigelt, now most widely grown grape in Austria (hybrid grape from 1922)

From Krems, Austria (similar latitude as Seattle) this wine exhibits intense, deep cherry fruit flavors. Due to the northern climate of the Kremstal vineyard, this wine combines the elegance of northern climate grapes with the temperament of the south.



**Abbeyville Chardonnay 2012**  
**Total Wine Price: \$13.99**

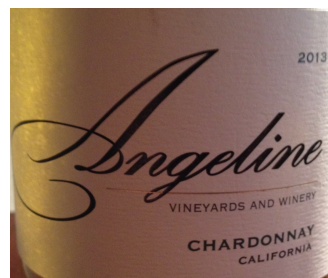
From North Coast, CA (about 30 mi from Napa). Abbeyville has complex mix of tropical and citrus tinged fruit character - hints of lemon and cantaloupe - balanced by buttery notes.



**Angeline Chardonnay California 2013**  
**Total Wine Price: \$9.99**

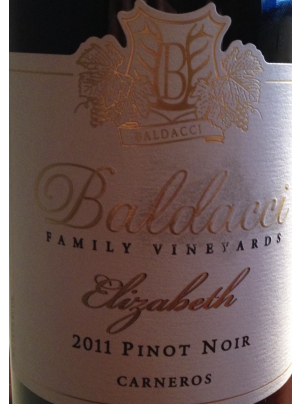
Starts off with a burst of tropical fruit that transitions to a decadently textured toasty oak and vanilla; full-bodied and creamy with a citrusy, crisp finish.

Blended from vineyards located in the costal regions of California, this is a representative of a classic California Chardonnay.



**Baldacci “Elizabeth” Pinot Noir  
Carneros 2011  
Total Wine Price: \$39.99**

Named after the winemaker’s mother, this Cab lovers Pinot Nor has dark garnet color and aromas of strawberris, pomegranate and cherry cola. Multiple flavors of red raspberries, plums and hints of fresh mushrooms are carried across the palate. Lovely finish.



**Vistamar Sepia Reserva 2013  
Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, Chile  
Total Wine Price: \$9.99**

Expressive aromas of fresh raspberries and cherries intertwined with notes of caramel and chocolate. Elegant with a pleasant and complex finish.

Chile is the 8th largest Pinot producer in the world but has great ambition to move up. This is a great value under \$10.



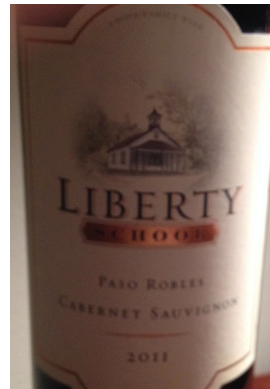
**Long Meadow Ranch Red Ranch House  
2009  
Total Wine Price: \$29.99**

Located at the Myacamas Estate in St. Helena, CA in the heart of Napa Valley, this red blend has aromas of plum and cherry followed by spicy notes. Generous and smooth flavors through. (62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Petite Syrah, 9% Sangiovese and 5% Cabernet Franc)/



**Liberty School Paso Robles  
Cabernet Sauvignon 2011  
Total Wine Price: \$11.97**

The Liberty School Label was originally created by Caymus Vineyards. Later sold to the Hope family, they sold their grapes back to Caymus. This cab opens with aromas of black sherry, plum and violets, followed by subtle flavors of strawberry and allspice. A lovely red for multiple food pairings.



**Mulderbosch Cabernet Rose 2013  
South Africa  
Total Wine Price: \$9.99**

From the coastal region of South Africa, after pressing, the Cabernet Sauvignon rose is handled just like a Sauvignon Blanc. This early bottling process preserves the wine's inherent freshness, zesty aromas and fresh mineral palate.



**Bougrier "V" Chenin-Blanc  
Vouvray, France  
Total Wine Price: \$9.99**

An example of the very versatile Chenin Blanc grape which has been grown for over 1300 years and can be crafted to any level of sweetness, ranging from bone-dry, crisp and sparkling, to sweet desert wines.

This version is considered off-dry with fruity and floral aromas displaying apricot and pear.
